### Technical Information

Receiving equipment: *Hammarlund HQ-180 A receiver with 1 foot ferrite core antenna (which gives excellent directional properties & ability to null)*

Interfering stations: *Very slight from The Hamden, Conn. station - however you are well atop 1220 here & quite easy to hear. There is also a slight amount of slop from WCAU on 1210.*

Reception conditions: *Fair - warm & cloudy - no static, but some line noise*
