Dear John:

This is to confirm your monitoring report of Dec. 30, 1977. We returned the station to the air after purchasing it from its old owners, WKQW Inc., who went bankrupt. It was off for approx. 3 years.

The station is daytime only, and runs 500 watts, directional. At present, we're operating with parameters at variance, until we can make our DA pattern more stable, and complete a directional proof for the FCC. The station is located in Nanuet, where the Palasades parkway intersects rte. 59, and the main lobe of the pattern is to the north west. Enclosed is a diagram of our pattern. The antenna array consists of three towers, in line. The studios are located in house trailers at the transmitter site.

If you're interested in visiting the station, give me a call ahead of time, during the week, and I'll be glad to show it to you.
