 223 Brief announcement (including a "Good by's Happy Easter" as I thought the show was ending), a more music
 224 Brief announcement by a man - then announcement of the time by woman, the same was read by a woman

 226 Current weather for Newark & vicinity - then announcement - "No live from Newark (that was the first time I ever saw the live) with the WRNU 640 kHz of WRNU Newark, New Jersey - back to our music with
 227 Breaking in music here - would like a cut from a song
