

This letter is to verify the reception of radio station W S A R on the date of 11/20/73 . WSAR's studios are located just outside of Fall River in Somerset, Massachusetts. WSAR operates on a frequency of 1480 KHz, with an output power of 5 kilowatts 24 hours a day.

The main transmitter is a Gates BC-5P 5000 watt broadcast transmitter with a one kilowatt Gates BC-1T auxiliary transmitter. WSAR's primary signal is beamed towards the southeast covering southern Massachusetts and most of Rhode Island. Daytime transmission is achieved through the use of two towers while a more restricted night pattern uses four towers, each of which are guyed and stand in excess of 400 feet in height.
