This is to verify your DX report of March 7, 1966

Our equipment here is a Continental Electronics 315B, 5000 watt transmitter using a pair of 4cx5000A's in parallel. Our antenna system is a 2-tower directional array. Both towers are 200 feet in height, spaced 437 feet apart. Our directional pattern is 5 degrees East of true North and 185 degrees South. The ground system is radials of buried copper wire 200 feet in length, spaced every 3 degrees. Thank you for your DX report. We shall be glad to hear from you any time you hear our station in your locality.
