Dear John:

This letter will confirm your reception of our AM signal at 0234 EST on December 3.

The announcer you heard was Marty Markham, doing the local news/weather.

We are a 24-hour a day station, running 1 KW daytime and 250 watts at night. The antenna is a series-fed vertical 405-feet high, and the pattern is omnidirectional.

Don't know if you monitor FM, but our sister station is WPLZ-FM, a fully-automated "Good Music" station which runs 3 KW ERP. 99.3 MHZ.

Your receiver is a good one; I have a Drake R-4 and do a little SWLing myself, now and then, although I primarily operate 6 and 2 meters (I'm KLMSG).

We do appreciate your report, and if you hear us again don't hesitate to drop us a line.
