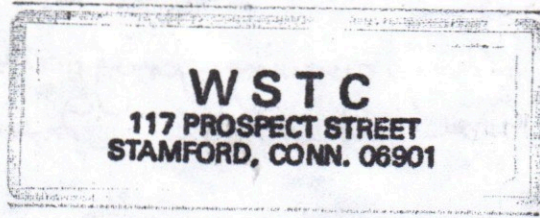

## Technical Information

Receiving equipment: *Collins UR388 receiver with 2 foot loop antenna (which gives excellent directional properties & ability to null)*

Interfering stations: *Very heavy from WEST in Easton, Pa & WOND in Pleasantville, N.J. You are not normally audible here but I*

Reception conditions: *Good - no atmospheric or line noise* | *was able to null both of the above to hear WSTC*
