Further to your report of January 24th regarding the DX Program which we ran, please find enclosed a schedule of our daily programs. We do not however have any printed coverage maps.

You may be interested to know that our transmitter is an RCA 10 Kilowatt unit located 10 miles south of Calgary which feeds a 450 and 230' tower. We use the 450' tower for daytime non-directional broadcasting and use both towers during the hours of darkness, when they are directional.

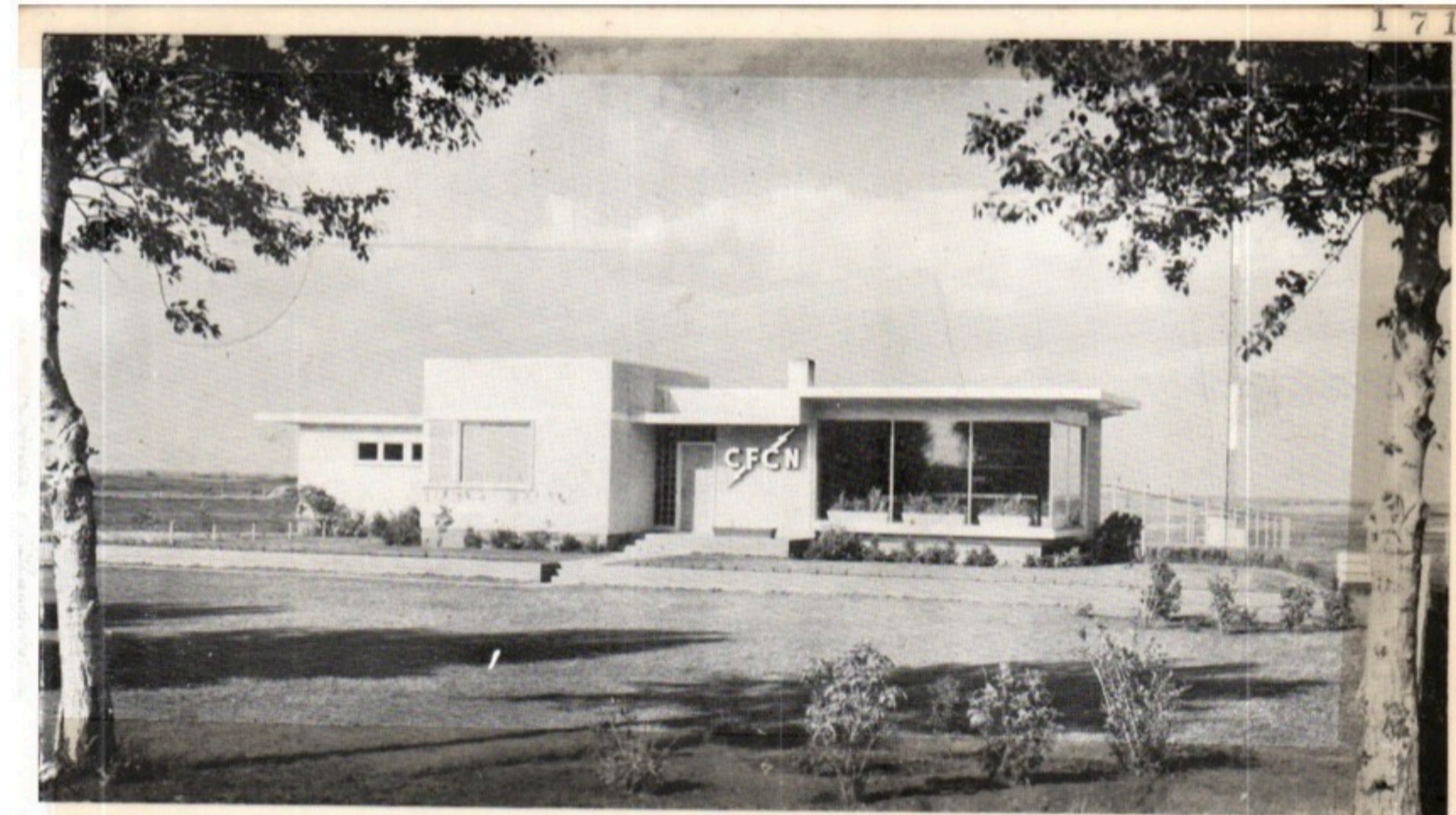
