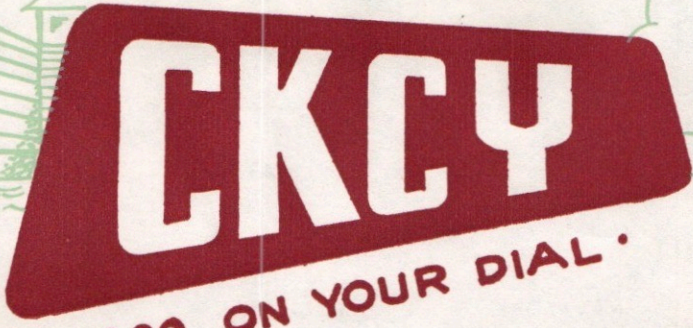
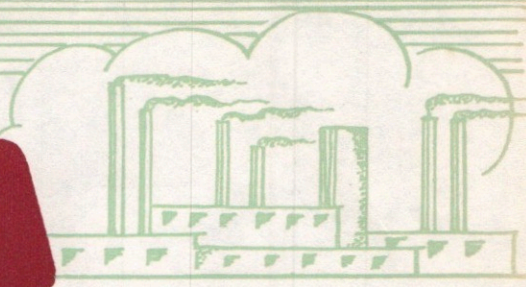

Glad to hear from you and your report on receiving CKCY on September 13, 1956.

You were quite correct in regard to the broadcast you heard. What you picked up was the sign off to our all night show, and our singing station break.

I have in my hand at present, a letter from another NRC member, Richard Northup of Iowa City who reports receiving CKCY from 2 to 205 (CST) on Sept. 18/56. He used an 8 tube National receiver with a 50 foot antenna. The Weather was clear with the temperature about 50 degrees at the time of reception.

I'm sorry we do not have a coverage map for mailing purposes, but I can tell you we broadcast on a .25 MV/M circular signal of about 35 miles.
