
Dear John:

Many thanks for your interesting DX report dated June 18th, 1956. I have checked it with our log and am pleased to report that it is correct.

CKXL operates twenty-four hours per day with a 1 KW R.C.A. rig on 1140 Kcs. We operate non-directional daytime and directional at night. Our two towers are 200 feet high and oriented 35 degrees West of due North. Our pattern of signals is pulled in from the south-west to protect Station KDGM, Stockton, California, and from the west by south-west to protect Station WRVA, Richmond, Virginia.

I hope this confirmation will be sufficient for your files.
