The reception of our station is correct and we are happy to receive a letter of this type. Yours is the second that has arrived at KANO in the past six months. The other came from New Jersey.

The Station signs on at 6:00 AM and signs off with the sunset. We are 1000 watts but are in between KSTP Radio who are 1500 in frequency and 50,000 watts of power. On the other side of us is a 5000 watt station, KEVE, and between the two we are having trouble getting into areas we would like to and should be covering. This spring we hope to boost to 5000 watts. Our tower is 274' overall height, uniform cross-section, series-excited, guyed wire vertical steel tower.
