KBIS at 970 kilocycles with one kilowatt of power broadcasts from Bakersfield, California serving the southern portion of the famous San Joaquin Valley. We are the only around-the-clock operation between Fresno to the north of us, and Los Angeles to the south.

Our portion of the "Great Valley" as it is often known is an agricultural giant. Kern County of which Bakersfield is the county seat is the third richest agricultural county in the nation; cotton - potatoes, grapes, alfalfa hay, grain and cotton seed being the principal crops, and in the order herein listed. Livestock has an annual county yield of now nearly 45-million dollars.

Kern County's oil production is slightly more than 26% of the state's total.
