

Dear Sir:

It would appear that your extensive identification of program and content of commercials leaves no doubt that you did in fact hear our station as noted, so I can verify your note.

Our broadcast hours on AM are 24 hr., we have 5000 watts, with two tower directional, with very minor dents in a couple of directions for daytime operation, and three tower 1000 watts directional at night, with much more complicated pattern and deeper nulls, with basically major lobes in approximately, NE, SW, and NW, SE directions, looking at the US map it would appear that you might be just out of the null to the South so would be getting a little more signal than if you were directly in it, it is very sharp, so that just a little way to either side the signal would come up quite fast, anyone in the center of the null has to be very close to the station to hear it, some joke that they can look up to see the top light before they begin to hear the station coming into town on the road to the south.

In your report you made only some very minor errors in spelling of some names that would sound similar to your spelling, they aren't very common names.
