Dear Listener,

I have your letter of recent date concerning reception of station KCOM in Omaha. We were not with the station at that time but your log of the program would still fit the station today so we are sure you received the station. The log of that date is filed pretty deep now and not here at my office, but we are convinced that you did receive the station.

As you state now the station is KMNS. We are not supposed to put much of a signal into Omaha as it is too close to the frequency of WOW. At the time we took over the technical direction of the station the pattern was badly out of adjustment but as of this date you should not be able to receive us very well even with the good equipment you have. We would like a report of "S" meter readings compared with some of your local stations.

We throw quite a large portion of our signal north so if the Northfield you speak of is in Minnesota we should be received well there.
