This is an acknowledgment and will serve as a verification of your report to us of reception of our radio station KDUB. We wish to express our great appreciation for such reports.

Radio Station KDUB is a subsidiary of KDUB-TV. Our location is Lubbock, Texas and our frequency is 1340 kilocycles. We have a Gates remote controlled transmitter with a radiated power of 250 watts. Our antenna is a 150 ft. series fed guyed tower, non-directional. Our antenna is located within the city limits of Lubbock in the south central area.

We went on with programming January 29, 1955 at 6:00 A.M., and will remain on 24 hours a day except for test schedules every four weeks on Monday mornings from 2:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M., and other maintenance periods as necessary. Periodic frequency checks are made by the Frequency Monitoring Service, Kansas City, Missouri.
