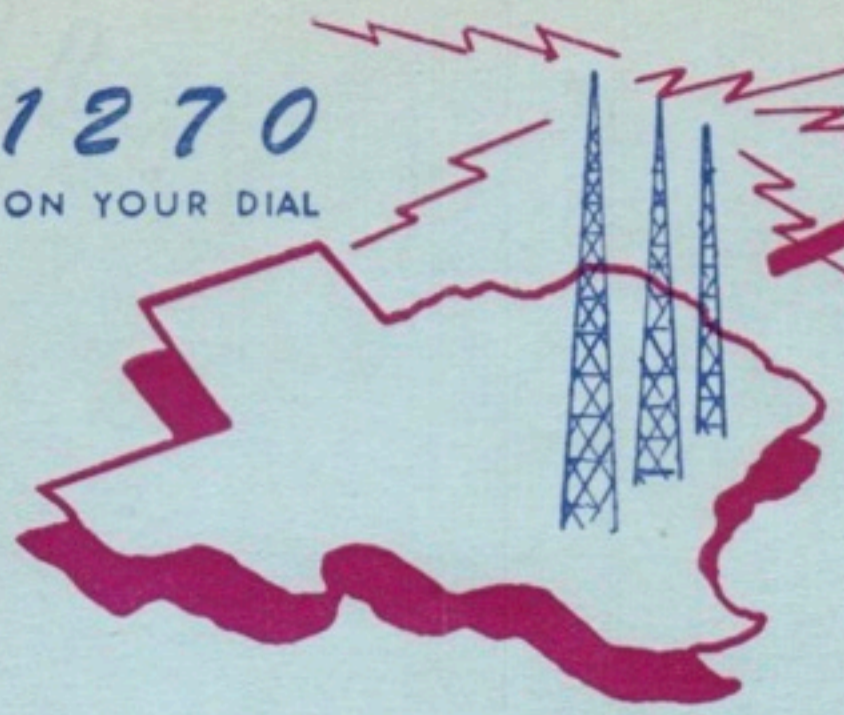

Enjoyed your reception report of our HURICANE WATCH of September 6th, this year. In three years with this station-- this was the first time we have been close enough "in the path," to necessitate our remaining on the air.

The attached card (our regular QSL) and this letter will serve to verify a very fine, thorough report as logged 4:35 to 4:55 AM, CST on September 6, 1958.

Back in "the good old days," 1947 through 1951, I was very active in DX circles... belonging to both NRC and NNRC--and working on the CPC of both clubs. Even edited a special mid-month bulletin for NNRC for some time during '48 and '49. This was all back in Springfield, Missouri. Most of the active DXers of that time will remember me as "Jack D"...not "Don," as I am now known. In fact, had two or three letters from boys I used to correspond with that didn't know to whom they were listening!.. hi!
