Yours is the second monitoring report that we've received this week. however, the other report came from Hammarstrand, Sweden. Our station is considered an "Adult Contemporary" station, however, at 9:40p.m. we switch an "easy Listening" format. The announcer you were listening to is our part-timer here and doesn't really follow the format. I am the regular night announcer but do not work on Wednesday and Saturday nights.


In your letter you stated that you were receiving heavy interference from KOLT (?) in Scottsbluff. I was wondering if you had heard a person by the name of Jed Johnsrud on KNEB out of Scottsbluff? He and I grew up about six houses away from each other in Albert Lea, Minnesota, and attended Brown Institute in Minneapolis at the same time.

I have included a coverage map for your information and collection. Our night pattern has been approximated in pencil on the map. However, there is not enough room on the map to show how far northward we beam our signal. As you can see, very little of our signal is sent southward at the time you were listening, so you probably picked us up by an atmospheric "skip."

Thanks for your letter, I find these letters quite interesting myself, which is why I answer them rather than my boss. He doesn't think there's such a big deal!
