### Technical Information

Receiving equipment: Collins UR388 receiver with 2 foot loop antenna (which gives excellent directional properties & ability to null)  
Interfering station: ~~None~~ during the day - you put an excellent signal in to Omaha - At nite - you are often audible, but also WCBS, New York, often interferes with you.
