We have our own transmitter and broadcast from Manhattan. WIBW's transmitter is in Topeka. The time-share agreement (in one form or another) has been in effect since 1929. 580 is KSAC's frequency. KSAC went on the air December 1st, 1924 (we're celebrating our 55th anniversary this year). Our present agreement with WIBW gives us the frequency each week-day afternoon from 12:30 to 5:30. We are not on the air on week-ends.
