Dear Mr. Sampson;

Nice to hear from you by letter. KTCH-AM is now operating at 2500 watts daytime (500 Pre-sunrise) on a directional pattern. I'm enclosing our rate card which shows you the .5 mv coverage on the back. We have a two tower array, with one 320 foot stick (with FM antenna) and a 150 footer about 130 feet due East (90°) of the tall tower. Our competition to the South is Great Bend, Kansas, KVGB, which is 5000 watts non-directional days, and 5000 directional north - south at night. We also protect Boone, Iowa to the East, which the FCC's major concern. Our FM is a 3000 watt E.R.P. at 300 foot above average terrain.

Hope this helps in your efforts. Glad to be a part of it.
