On behalf of Radio Station KTLN, I would like to acknowledge your letter indicating reception of our signal. We enjoy receiving letters such as yours as it is the only indication we have of our distant listeners.

Our studios are located at Radio Center in the Zook Building in Downtown Denver. The transmitter and antenna site is located approximately 10 miles due south of Downtown Denver. We operate with 5,000 watts of power and are directional both day and night. Our major radiation is in a northern direction.

Our directional antenna system operates with four 200 foot towers arranged in a 45° parallelogram. The spacing of the towers east and west is 443 feet, and 192 feet north and south.

The complete station installation uses equipment built by the Gates Radio Company of Quincy, Illinois.
