Please let this serve as a letter of confirmation of your reception of our station, from 2:17 to 2:28 A.M. Eastern Standard Time on Monday, December 19, 1955. We returned to the air for testing purposes.

KTLW is located in Texas City, Texas approximately ten miles West of Galveston. We are a daytime operation, transmitting on a frequency of 920 KC with a power output of 1000 watts. We use a Gates BC-1E Xmitter, with twin 833A's for high level Modulators, and two 500 watt 833A's in the Finals. The overall height of our antenna tower is 245'.
