Thank you a lot for your letter of reception of KTOK on December 22nd, 4:11 to 4:19 PM. Your report checks with our station program log.

You were receiving KTOK on its day time pattern, which is essentially non-directional. Our signal is pulled in toward KFDX at Wichita Falls, Texas. This station being on 990 KC.

We operate on 5 KW day and night. The nighttime pattern is highly directional. The pattern being a figure eight. The upper lobe runs northwest, sandwiched between WCFL, Chicago and KOMO in Seattle. The lower lobe in the direction of Shreport from Okla. City.
