
Sorry about this oversight. At that time I was in the middle of rewiring the studio and did not even know my own name. I thought I had answered you but I guess I did not. Your report is correct to the letter.

You may be interested in some of the details about the operation here at KTTN. The frequency is of course 1600 kcs. the power 500 watts. Our tower is 98 feet high and is not lighted. the antenna radiation resistance is 12.7 ohms therefore the antenna is very efficient. The ground system is 120 3 degree radials 150 feet long. The equipment is Gates through out.

I think that raps it up except to say again that I am sorry about this oversight on my part. I thank you for your interest and hope to hear from you again soon.
