Dear John,

Thanks very much for your FB report on the reception of KWAK in Omaha, Nebraska, on August 24, 1954, from 1:45 to 2:00 AM, Central Standard Time, on 1240 kilocycles. Your report is 100% correct, so we are happy to verify your reception of Radio Station, KWAK, Stuttgart, Arkansas, at the times mentioned above. We are always happy to hear from DX'ers around the country regarding reception of the station, and I, personally speaking, am especially happy to hear from members of the NNRC or the NRC, as I'm a member of the NRC. According to the chief engineer, we have been reported heard from New Zealand. Unfortunately, this was before I began answering the reports, and I didn't get to see it.

Our present sked is as follows: Monday through Saturday, 5:30 AM to 11 PM, and Sundays, 7:00 to 10:30, Central Standard Time. Our frequency check and maintenance test period is the fourth Tuesday of each month from 1:45 to 2. This was the broadcast you heard. On this show, tone is used, and we are monitored by Commercial, in Kansas City. On the test you heard, we were measured as being 1.5 c.p.s. lower than our assigned frequency. That leaves us plenty of room before 20 off.

We use a Gates Radio Type 250-C xmtr. The antenna is a 207 foot guyed, constant, vertical radiator, series-fed over an open coaxial transmission line.

I hope that you will have many more hours of enjoyable DXing. 73s!
