Thank you for your DX report no. 124 heard on January 6.

The Broadcast you heard was the end of a newscast I was giving at around sign-off time. After the sign-off announcement I went off immediately. Our broadcasting schedule is 6:00 A.M. to local sunset or until 6:00 P.M. during the summer months, on 1430 kc.

We use a Western Electric transmitter and are non-directional, daytime only. Our tower is series-excited 195' tall (199' overall height).

To my knowledge, yours is the most distant DX report received as a result of a daylight broadcast here.
