Dear Mr. Cooke,

Last year, on April 1, 1956, I heard WCTA broadcasting from my home in Omaha, Nebraska. At that time, I wrote a reception report, but as it was never answered, it must have been lost between Omaha and Andalusa. So, I am again writing in an attempt to get a verification of reception from WCTA.

I heard your station from 5:17 to 5:21 A. M. on Easter morning broadcasting the following programs on a frequency of 920 kc.

- : 5:17 Opening Prayer
- 5:18 Station announcement and announcement of a program to be presented at 6:00--"Sunrise Service" from the Andalusa Municipal Stadium
- 5:19 Start of the program "Gospel Time" featuring gospel songs until 5:40
- 5:21 Announcement of title of the program to be presented at 5:40 and of a newscast at 5:55. Then came an announcement of the correct time.
- 5:21 $\frac{1}{2}$ Song

There was no interference from any station, but WCTA was rather difficult to hear due to a fairly weak signal (as it was almost sunrise in Omaha at that time) I used a Hallicrafters S-53A receiver with 100 foot long wire antenna.

As I stated before, I would greatly appreciate a verification of reception from your station, and an enclosing return postage in the form of a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience in replying.
