We are grateful for the trouble you have taken to post us with respect to the details concerning the reception of our signal in your area. Your report was correct in every detail, and we thank you again for submitting it.

In your reception report you requested information regarding our schedule and signal pattern. During the week and Saturday we sign on at sunrise and off at sunset. Sundays 7:00 A.M. to sunset. Our signal pattern is non-directional, interference free in a seven county area.

You may be interested in knowing that we received reports from 26 different states, and two from Canada. We had one other report from Nebraska, from a 72 year old woman in Page, Nebraska, who picked us up on an AM radio.

We are planning another test broadcast in several months and would appreciate hearing from you again if you happen to pick us up then. Again many thanks for your report.
