Thanks very much for the report. THIS LETTER IS TO VERIFY YOUR REPORT OF RECEPTION ON FEB. 2, 1958. Your reply has been most helpful.

Ours is a brand new station. After completing our tests, we will start regular programming, probably in a few weeks.

Our studios are in the Southern Hotel on the 7th floor. Our transmitter is located about 5 miles southwest of the city limits of Columbus at an elevation of 800 feet. Our equipment is mostly RCA. The transmitter is an RCA BTA-500-MX, 500 watts. Our towers are 4 in number and are 270 feet high. When we go on with regular programming, we will be directional north-northeast. Our tests, however, were made non-directional.

Sorry we couldn't send reply on our letter head, but they haven't been printed yet.
