This will acknowledge your report of reception of WMON on the morning of January 17th, during our frequency check transmission.

I am glad to say that your report checks with the log of transmission on the above date, so therefore we can verify your reception of our station on this occasion.

We operate from 6:15 a.m. till midnight, EST, Mondays thru Saturdays, and from 7:30 a.m. till midnight on Sundays. Our frequency checks are on the third monday of each month and measurements are made by the Hedrick Frequency Service at Winston-Salem, N.C.

We are located 27 miles east of Charleston, the state capital, and have the usual 250 watt local station set-up, using Collins, Raytheon, RCA and General Radio equipment.
