Dear Sir:

Last February, I heard your station from my location in Omaha, Nebraska. At that time, I sent a report of reception to WMSJ. However, as I have not received an answer, I guess that my report got lost in the mails, and so am writing again, in hopes of receiving a verification of reception from WMSJ.

I heard WMSJ on February 3, 1958 broadcasting a combined frequency check and equipment test on 1480 kcs, from 3:53 A. M. to 4:00 A. M., EST. My loggings were as follows:

- 3:53 Station identification and announcement that the program in progress was a frequency check and equipment test. There was also an announcement of the station's telephone number--Justice 6-2221.
- 3:53½ Music by a dance band
- 3:56 Song--featuring a trumpet solo
- 3:58½ Station ID and music by Benny Goodman
- 4:00 Announcement of the correct time, and the station left the air

Although there was quite heavy interference from WSAR in Fall River, Mass, WMSJ was very strong here, and quite easy to hear. WSAR was the only station interfering with you.

If the above report is correct, I would greatly appreciate a verification of reception--on your letterhead stationary, if possible. I am enclosing return postage in the form of a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience in replying. I feel quite fortunate to have chanced upon your test, and would prize a verification from you.
