Dear Mr. Mandel:

Last fall, on Wednesday, November 19, 1997, from 4:28 PM to 4:46 PM (Pacific Standard Time), I received a portion of KAMP's broadcasts on 1430 kHz. At that time, I submitted a reception report outlining what I had heard on KAMP from my location (about 20 miles northwest of Phoenix). Since I haven't received a confirmation as yet, it appears that my report went astray somewhere along the line. I am very anxious to add KAMP to my list of confirmed AM broadcast stations and so am submitting my report again.

My hobby is listening to the standard AM Broadcast Band for radio stations, writing to the stations informing them of my reception and requesting a confirmation of this reception. I have collected over 3000 such confirmations from different stations and would prize a KAMP confirmation to add to this.

Items and announcements I heard over KAMP on November 19, 1997, follow:

- 4:28 A song was in progress when you became audible
- 4:31 Station ID ("The most music, KAMP; this is the place, one oldie after another on the All Request Show"), you faded briefly and when you became audible again, a request was in progress
- 4:33 Song ("Do Wah Ditty Ditty")
- 4:34 Announcement ("Playing the good time oldies back-to-back...") and a telephone request was taken from Joe, followed by a song by Santos and Johnny
- 4:37 Station ID ("Best Oldies, KAMP") and your signal faded briefly
- 4:38 Ad for Natural Gas Irrigation with help from the Gas Company (and for more information, call the Gas Company at 909-335-7993) and song ("Lazy Day")
- 4:41 Musical Station ID ("Oldies on your radio, oldies radio; KAMP") and song ("The Game of Love
- 4:46 Announcement and song ("Sitting on the Dock of the Bay") and you faded again; this time for good

I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KAMP. Your signal was on top of 1430 (except during the fades) until 4:46. There was interference from several other stations, also.

May I suggest a confirmation format; this on your KAMP letterhead:

"Mr. Sampson:

This will confirm your reception of KAMP on November 19, 1997.

(signature)"

That would be ideal for my collection and, I hope, not too much trouble for you. I have also enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope to further facilitate reply.

Many thanks in advance for your time, consideration and assistance. I hope that this report has been of interest to you and I will be looking forward to a confirmation.
