Thank you for your reception report dated Sunday, April 4, 2004. Your report is valuable to us as to just how the 1650 signal is getting out propagation wise. It appears the ionosphere is skipping the signal around all over the place.

Before KBIV signed on the air we could hear both KBJD in Denver and KFOX in Torrance with pretty strong signals into the El Paso area so wondered just how it would do. Most x-banders have a power of 1-Kw at night and 10-kw during daytime operations. Since KBIV is so close to the Mexican border we are only allowed 8,500 watts daytime and 850 watts night.

We confirm that the information you sent in your reception report is correct.
