Dear Mr. Suter:

Last fall, on Tuesday, October 13, 1998, from 1:07 AM to 1:33 AM (Central Daylight Time), I received a portion of KCJK's broadcasts on 1630 kHz. At that time, I submitted a reception report outlining what I had heard on KCJK from my location (about 20 miles northwest of Phoenix). Since I haven't received a confirmation as yet, it appears that my report went astray somewhere along the line. I am very anxious to add KCJK to my list of confirmed AM broadcast stations and so am submitting my report again.

My hobby is listening to the standard AM Broadcast Band for radio stations, writing to the stations informing them of my reception and requesting a confirmation of this reception. I have collected over 3000 such confirmations from different stations and would prize a KCJK confirmation to add to this, in particular since the KCJK call is no longer being used. I noticed in a recent issue of the National Radio Club's DX News that you had provided such a confirmation of reception of KCJJ to another NRC member, so I am directing this report to you in hopes that you can help me also for a KCJK confirmation.

Items and announcements I heard over KCJK on October 13 follow:

- 1:07 Music (in progress when I tuned in)
- 1:09 Station ID ("You're listening to the new 1630, KCJJ, Eastern Iowa's most powerful radio station. If you're receiving this broadcast, please call us at 319-354-1242, 319-354-1242; Eastern Iowa's most powerful radio station, the new 1630, KCJJ", followed by more music)
- 1:11 Station ID (similar to the one at 1:09), followed by more music
- 1:15 Announcement, including that "this radio station is broadcasting with digital audio in AM stereo, it's owned and operated by River City Radio. We are licensed as KCJK, KCJJ, Iowa City and Coralville ...", followed by more music
- 1:17 Your signal faded briefly but returned in about a minute
  
- 1:19 Announcement and more music
- 1:22 Announcement (and thanks for telephone calls from Phoenix and Denver) and music
- 1:23 Announcement and music ("Only the Good Die Young")
- 1:26 Announcement and music
- 1:33 A sign-off announcement was given, including that you would begin regular broadcasting on Wednesday at 6 AM, that your mailing address is KCJJ, Box 2116, Iowa City, Iowa, 52244, and that your 1630 outlet is licensed as KCJK

I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KCJK. Your signal was generally very strong here with no interference. Also, I called KCJK that evening to let you know that you were being received very well in the Phoenix area.

May I suggest a confirmation format; this on your KCJJ letterhead:

"Mr. Sampson:


This will confirm your reception of KCJK on 1630 kHz on October 13, 1999.

That would be ideal for my collection and, I hope, not too much trouble for you. I have also enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope to further facilitate reply.

Many thanks in advance for your time, consideration and assistance. I hope that this report has been of interest to you and I will be looking forward to a confirmation.


