Radio Station KCWW:

On Friday, November 13, 1998, from 2:50 PM to 3:03 PM (Mountain Standard Time), it was my pleasure to monitor a portion of the transmissions of KCWW on 1580 kHz from my location, which is about 20 miles northwest of Phoenix. As proof of this reception, I offer the following listing of items I heard:

- 2:50 Song (in progress when I tuned in)
- 2:52 Announcement ("AM 1580, Radio Disney, Phoenix") and song ("Peggy Sue")
- 2:56 Happy Birthdays (including recorded telephone messages)
- 2:57 Announcement ("Radio Disney, we're all ears"), followed by a commercial break with ads for "The Lion King II, prizes on Radio Disney, "What's Cool" on Radio Disney, the Weekly Reader on Radio Disney and the Radio Disney Web Site
- 3:00 Station ID ("AM 1580, KCWW, Tempe, Phoenix") and return to the "Mark and Zippy Thing" with music
- 3:03 Announcement and song ("Crocodile Rock")

I used a Drake R8B receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KCWW. Your signal is very strong here during daylight, however at night, you are often hashed by the Mexican station in Hermosillo. Interestingly enough, I heard you loud and clear at night while in Puerto Peñasco, Sonora, last year and recently when in San Diego.

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I indeed received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and have some 3000 at present. I would greatly appreciate a letter from KCWW to add to my collection. In fact, a statement, such as

"Mr. Sampson:


This will confirm your reception of KCWW on November 13, 1998.
