



Mr. Sampson:

This will confirm your reception of KFAM on April 23, 1998. I apologize for the lag in returning a letter to you, but the station was going through a sale and the former owner had also filed for bankruptcy during the period of the sale.

The station's call letters were changed in July to KWLW when it was purchased by Jacor Communications of Salt Lake City. As of yet, there is no letterhead with this station's calls on it, and the only thing I could find at the KFAM site was the enclosed envelope.

In the next year we will be increasing the nighttime power of AM700 from 1kW to 10kW. This should improve your reception of our signal.
