Thank you for the reception report. I must apologize for the lateness of this letter. The letter was placed on my desk instead of the chief engineer of the station and it became buried under a pile for several months. Once again I'm sorry.

I am pleased to confirm that you have indeed received KIRN on January 22, 2002. The language you heard was Farsi and you heard it on the only Iranian radio station outside of Iran.

You were listening to the station while we were at night power. The station runs the same pattern both day and night but switches from 5 KW day to 3 KW at night. We are in the process of increasing the power to 35 KW both day and night. The pattern is quite tight and sends almost all of the signal straight south. I would imagine that there was less than a couple of hundred watts going in the direction of Arizona on that morning.
