Radio Station KIVA:

On Sunday, October 20, 1996, from 11:49 PM to (Monday, October 21) 12:06 AM (Mountain Daylight Time), it was my pleasure to monitor a portion of the transmissions of KIVA on 1310 kHz. As proof of this reception, I offer the following listing of items I heard:

- 11:49 Song ("It's a Good Life")
- 11:51 Announcement, including a "thanks for listening" from Joe Waldman and that "we'll do this again next Saturday and Sunday"
- 11:52 Ad for Sun Source Insomnia Relief, followed by an ad for "Ester C"
- 11:53 Announcement concerning the dangers of lead from the EPA and Americal Cancer Society
- 11:54 Ad for the Wildlife Way Station, announcement and song ("Crying in the Chapel")
- 11:57 Announcement ("Tell a friend about your radio station, 1310 AM, KIVA, 'kiva'")
- 11:59 Your signal faded for several minutes
- 12:03 When you became audible again, the news was just ending, there was an announcement ("KIVA") and a song ("Mockingbird Hill") started
- 12:06 Brief announcement, start of a song and you faded again


I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KIVA. Your signal was surprisingly strong until the 11:59 fade and you were well on top of 1310. There was interference from several others, including semi-local KXAM, Mesa (who became stronger after 12:00).

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I indeed received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and have some 3000 at present. I would greatly appreciate a letter from KIVA to add to my collection. In fact, a statement, such as

"Mr. Sampson:

This will confirm your reception of KIVA on October 20, 1996


(signature)"
