

Thank you for your letter regarding the reception of KLVZ Radio on January 28, 2000. We have found your reception report to be completely accurate, and are pleased to verify your report.

A little background on KLDC. We acquired the station in the summer of 1993. It broadcasts with 1,000 watts during the daytime, and 7 watts at night. The station used to belong to a local owner, and was programmed as a Christian music station. We broadcast Gospel music and talk programs.

KLDC is owned by Crawford Broadcasting Company, which -- as you can see from the sidebar -- has a number of stations around the country. While the majority of the stations are Christian program oriented, there are a few that broadcast an "Adult Standards" format (Perry Como, Barbara Streisand, Frank Sinatra, etc...). KLZ in Denver is one of those stations. We broadcast on 560 kHz with 5,000 watts utilizing two towers. That station is the oldest in Colorado, having been on the air since March of 1922.

In addition, we operate the following stations in Colorado: KLTT 670 AM, KLVZ 1220 AM -- both in the Denver area -- and KCBR 1040 AM, and KCMN 1530 AM in Colorado Springs.

Once again, thanks for taking the time to write to us. Feel free to write again if you happen to hear one of our other Colorado stations.
