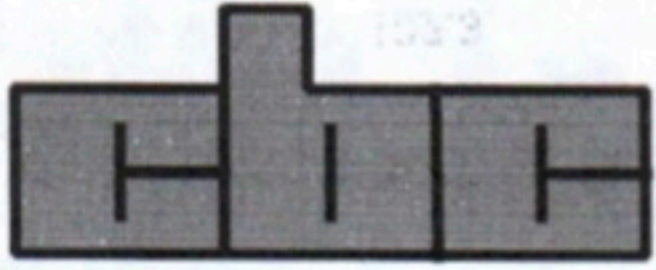

Mr. Sampson,

Thank you for your letter regarding the reception of KLTT Radio on January 17, 2000. We have found your reception report to be completely accurate, and are pleased to verify your report.

A little background on KLTT. The station is relatively new, as it began broadcasting in January of 1996. It is a 50,000 watt facility during the daytime, utilizing three towers, with a main lobe lying directly over Denver. Since its transmitter is located about 15 miles NNE of the Denver area, this would put your location within the main lobe of signal as well. During the evening, we reduce power to 1,400 watts, and utilize four towers. The main lobe is still over the Denver area, however it is much smaller to protect other stations on nearby frequencies. In addition, we must protect WMAQ in Chicago, and KBOI in Boise during the evening hours.

KLTT is owned by Crawford Broadcasting Company, which -- as you can see from the sidebar -- has a number of stations around the country. While the majority of the stations are Christian program oriented, there are a few that broadcast an "Adult Standards" format (Perry Como, Barbara Streisand, Frank Sinatra, etc...). KLZ in Denver is one of those stations. We broadcast on 560 kHz with 5,000 watts utilizing two towers. That station is the oldest in Colorado, having been on the air since March of 1922.

Once again, thanks for taking the time to write to us. Feel free to write again if you happen to hear one of our other Colorado stations.
