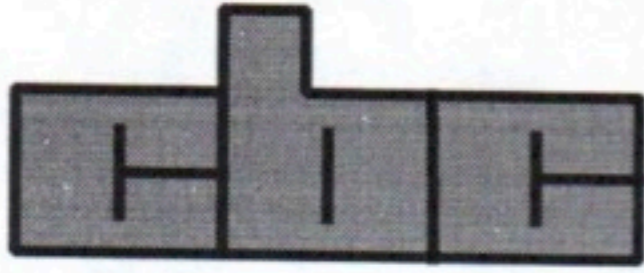

Mr. Sampson,

Thank you for your letter regarding the reception of KLVZ Radio on January 28, 2000. We have found your reception report to be completely accurate, with the exception of your reception of our shortened calls as "KLZ" rather than "KLV", and are pleased to verify your report.

A little background on KLVZ. We acquired the station in the late summer of 1999. It broadcasts with 660 watts during the daytime, and 17 watts at night. The station used to belong to a local owner, and was programmed as a Spanish music station. We broadcast contemporary Christian music, and a couple of talk programs.

KLVZ is owned by Crawford Broadcasting Company, which -- as you can see from the sidebar -- has a number of stations around the country. While the majority of the stations are Christian program oriented, there are a few that broadcast an "Adult Standards" format (Perry Como, Barbara Streisand, Frank Sinatra, etc...). KLZ in Denver is one of those stations. We broadcast on 560 kHz with 5,000 watts utilizing two towers. That station is the oldest in Colorado, having been on the air since March of 1922.

In addition, we operate the following stations in Colorado: KLTT 670 AM, KLDC 800 AM -- both in the Denver area -- and KCBR 1040 AM, and KCMN 1530 AM in Colorado Springs.

Once again, thanks for taking the time to write to us. Feel free to write again if you happen to hear one of our other Colorado stations.
