Re: Your request for Reception Confirmation

This shall serve as confirmation that you did, indeed, receive KPLS programming on the Date December 15, 1999 at the times you specified.

KPLS transmits from a mountain top location in San Bernardino County (3000'). Daytime power is 6350 watts non-directional. Nighttime power is 1000 watts, directional, with minimal signal to to east, north and south. The signal is directed towards Los Angeles and Orange Counties..

We are currently building a new transmitter site, 2 miles away from our current site, but on the ground.. This site will enable us to broadcast with 50,000 watts directional during the day, and 25,000 watts directional at night... Virtually all of the signal will be directed towards Los Angeles and Orange Counties. This new site has been in the planning (and re-planning) stage since 1991, and construction began in August of this year.. We hope to be completed and on the air from our new site in March of 2000. In the interim, we will broadcast from the new site during the daytime only, at 10,000 watts non-directional..
