Dear Mr. Maranville

Last October , I received a portion of KUKQ's broadcasts on 1060 kHz. At that time, I submitted a reception report outlining what I had heard on KUKQ from my location about 20 miles northwest of Phoenix. Since I haven't received a confirmation as yet, it appears that my report went astray somewhere along the line. I am very anxious to add KUKQ to my list of confirmed AM broadcast stations and so am submitting my report again.

My hobby is listening to the standard AM Broadcast Band for radio stations, writing to the stations informing them of my reception and requesting a confirmation of this reception. I have collected over 3000 such confirmations from different stations and would prize a KUKQ confirmation to add to this.

Items and announcements I heard over KUKQ on Saturday, October 26, 1996, from 9:50 AM to 10:07 AM (Mountain Standard Time) follow:

- 9:50 Pregame from the Sports Fan Radio Network (in progress) with an interview with Gene Stallings
- 9:55 Ads for a program on the USA Network, giving flowers, Trojan Condoms, the Sports Fan on-line Web Site, PSAs for the Coalition for America's Children, Halloween Safety and an ad for the NFL Visa Card
- 10:00 "The Drill"
- 10:02 Ad for Empire Diamonds and return to "The Drill"
- 10:04 Announcement that Pac-Ten football (USC) would be broadcast after the Coyotes' Hockey game tonight on "AM-1060, the Deuce"
- 10:05 PSAs for voting and to "turn your daughter on to science" and ad for Scott Purcell, "on the bench", evenings on "the Deuce"
- 10:07 Announcement ("Your Sports MVP, AM-1060, the Deuce") and back to the Pregame show


I used a Collins R388 receiver with two foot loop antenna to hear KUKQ. You put a good, listenable signal into Sun City West day and night.

May I suggest a confirmation format; this on your KUKQ letterhead:

"Mr. Sampson:

This will confirm your reception of KUKQ on October 26, 1996.


