
Dear Mr. Sampson,



### FACTS CONCERNING WGN

**WGN** came into existence on June 1, 1924, when Tribune Company acquired station WDAP and changed the call letters to **WGN** (World's Greatest Newspaper). The station has been an integral part of the Chicago Community ever since.

The station achieved national attention quickly when it broadcast the famous Scopes "Monkey Trial" in 1925. Remote broadcasting expanded to include live band pickups during the thirties and forties. **WGN** now uses an array of technical facilities to initiate live broadcasts from anywhere in the world. The station is the voice of the Chicago Bears and Cubs and it carries many college basketball and football games. It also operates a fully equipped mobile studio.

**WGN's** signal covers a major portion of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Wisconsin and Iowa during daylight hours. At night, it reaches into some part of at least 38 states, attracting regular listeners through its unique programming.

**WGN** studios are in the Tribune Tower, located on Michigan Avenue in downtown Chicago. The transmitter operates from a 100 acre site in Elk Grove, Illinois, which is 26 miles from the studios.
