I am pleased to verify your reception of WRNC (AM) operating at 1670 KHZ with transmitter located in Warner Robins, Georgia. WRNC operates with a daytime power of 10 kW and a nighttime power of 1 KW. Our antenna system is non-directional. Miscellaneous technical details follow:

Transmitter: Harris DX-10 solid state with AMS-G1 stereo exciter.

Antenna: LBA 6 wire symmetrical folded dipole 92 m high.

Elevation: tower base 125m AMSL

Location: 32 38 19 83 38 33

Initial Broadcast: 4 May 1998

Programming: country/ simulcasts with WRNC-FM 96.5 MHz (Gray, Ga.)
