Radio Station XEBACH:

On Monday, April 26, 1999, from 8:27 PM to 8:59 PM (Pacific Daylight Time), it was my pleasure to monitor a portion of the transmissions of XEBACH on 540 kHz from my location, which is about 20 miles northwest of Phoenix. As proof of this reception, I offer the following listing of items I heard:


- 8:27 Announcement concerning the San Diego Chamber Orchestra's final performance of the year (April 30 at 8PM)
- 8:28 Announcement (concerning artichokes) from Trader Joe's, followed by an ad for Golf Digest and a piano musical interlude
- 8:30 Announcement by a man in Spanish ("XEBACH, Tijuana, Mexico"), then announcement by a woman in English (including, "You're tuned to X-Bach, San Diego's first choice for classical music") and Schubert's Piano Sonata in A Major
- 8:56 Announcement by the woman and announcement concerning the San Diego Opera's May 3 performance of "The Masked Ball"
- 8:57 Ad for the Army and Navy Academy in Carlsbad, followed by a musical interlude
- 8:59 Announcement in Spanish by the man (as at 8:30), announcement by the woman and Lizst's Dante Symphony

I used a Drake R8B receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive XEBACH. Your signal was unusually strong last night. There was some interference from another Mexican station (probably XEWA); you faded occasionally but generally your signal was listenable. I wish we had a station such as yours in the Phoenix area.

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I indeed received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and have some 3000 at present. I would greatly appreciate a letter from XEBACH to add to my collection. In fact, a statement, such as

"Mr. Sampson:


This will confirm your reception of XEBACH on April 26, 1999.
