- 3:43½ Announcement that Len Phillips is the host on a "waggle" 50-50 weekend & song by The Beach Boys
- 3:45 Announcement of the time, & then a PSA to USE safety Belts
- 3:46 Your signal faded suddenly about this time (you didn't drop to your "critical hours" power, did you?)
- 3:49 Song (in progress)
- 3:51 Announcement (which I could not understand because of the interference) & a song - "Hey there little girl"
- 3:54 Announcement of the weather conditions & song
- 3:58 Announcement & song - "Raunchy" briefly - then a weather cast
- 3:59 Ad for the Lancaster Motor Co (Chevrolet, Olds & Cadillac dealer)
- 4:00 Station ID & ad for 8 track auto stereo cartridge units avail-able at Cody Tire Co, & a song was then played.
