Thank you for your reception report of WAVA-AM on
February 2, 1970. Your report agrees with our
station logs.

WAVA-AM operates with 1,000w non-directional on
780kHz. Our transmitter is located at 5232 Lee Highway in
Arlington and is a modern, transistorized Gates Vanguard II.

WAVA-FM operates at 105.1Mhz with effective radiated
power of 20,000w. WAVA-FM's transmitter is also at 5232 Lee
Highway with an antenna height of 740 feet above sea level.

Our broadcasting studios are located on the 12th
floor of the Rosslyn Building overlooking the Potomac River
and Washington, D. C.

Our programming is all-news, 24 hours a day--the
only such station in the nation's capital area.
