- 8:30 Station ID & latest news from the AP & WAXU newsroom.
- 8:32 1/2 you faded briefly & when you came back in an announcement concerning job opportunities from the State Employment Service was in progress.
- 8:33 Latest Kentucky News
- 8:34 Musical introduction & weather forecast
- 8:34 1/2 your signal faded briefly
- 8:35 1/2 Song by a woman (in progress)
- 8:37 Ad for Coca Cola
- 8:37 1/2 Announcement (your signal was faint) & song "Leavin' on a Jet Plane"
- 8:40 Announcement of Cincinnati baseball scores from the WAXU sports room
- 8:41 1/2 Musical Station ID - then the "Broadcasters Prayer" was given

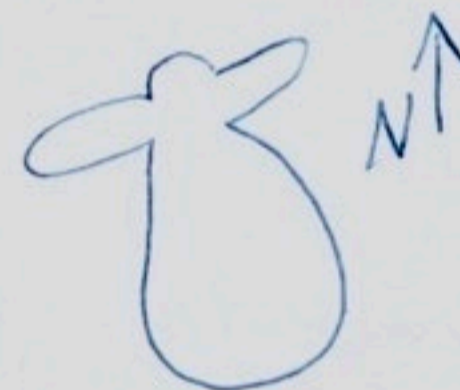
