Monitoring Report for Radio Station WEED on 1390 kHz.

Date Tuesday March 16, 1971 Monitoring period 5:59 1/2 AM to 6:01 1/2 AM EST

It was my pleasure to monitor transmissions from your station during the above period. As proof of reception I offer this log of items heard:

I heard WEED for a brief portion only, however, I was able to tape your sign on announcement, & copied it below as best as I could. I hope that it is a recorded one you use all the time & that it will be recognizable enough to warrant a WEED confirmation.

"Good morning This is WEED & WEED-FM in Rocky Mount, North Carolina, owned & operated by Radio Station WEED, Inc., William Curwll Wynne, President. WEED operates on an assigned frequency of 1390 kilocycles with a power of 5000 watts day time, 1000 watts night, & a pre-sunrise authority of 500 (over)*

I collect these letters as a hobby and would be most pleased to add your confirmation to my collection. Technical Information

Receiving equipment: *Hammerlund HQ-180-A receiver; 4 1/2 foot loop antenna (loop antenna gives excellent directionality-enabling nulling of dominant station)*
Interfering stations: *Heard from WCSC, Charleston, SC & a few others signing on at 6. I have heard bits of you before but usually 1390 is an impossibility here due to the proximity of WTOB on 1380. They happen to be directional at 6:00 AM. Heard to be some more on 1390*
Reception conditions: *Good - no static - temp*
